



Pond works at Dothill Local Nature Reserve

21st February 2022 to 4th March 2022

Ponds are going to be restored in the area of Dothill Local Nature Reserve from 21st February 2022 to 4th March 2022.

Please be aware that heavy machinery will be present and working in the area and that tree felling will also be occurring.

These Ponds are being restored part of the Council's ongoing positive management of the Local Nature Reserve which will increase biodiversity, including value for great crested newts. The pond will be left to vegetate and water levels restore naturally and will be monitored throughout the coming year.

Some tree removal is necessary in order to restore the pond. Good quality ponds provide significant carbon storage and are part of the Council's actions to address climate change across a range of local sites.

Footpaths will remain accessible during the works. The contractor will access the site from Harley Close and the works may take around a week to complete. The contractor will be taking heavy machinery onto the site to complete the works and we apologise for any inconvenience during this time.
